
Children's Book Review

Set in ancient China, when the secret of silk had spread wealth across the country. Red Butterfly follows a young princess as she prepares for her marriage to the king of a distant land. Desperate to take with her a piece of her homeland, she smuggles tiny silk worms in her elaborate hair-do, passing the secret of China's success on to her husband's country of Khotan. In telling this Chinese legend, Deborah Noyes has used the traditional verse form of Chinese poetry giving the book a magical incantatory feel. The Chinese legend is fascinating but the rhythm of the prose and the splendid illustrations makes this book a true indulgence of the senses. Butterfly's homesickness will resonate with any child who has lost their home or struggles with separation. Her apparent bravery and her boldness in stealing the silk secret show her as a strong feminine figure despite her traditional and socially restrictive setting.
