childrens book review

Inspired by his nephews complaining that there was nothing suitable for them to read, Robert Muchamore started the CHERUB series of books in 2004. There are now 10 books in the series with the 11th due for release in September 2008. The CHERUB series follows the adventures of 12 year old James and his 10 year old sister Lauren.

Following the death of his alcoholic, shoplifting mother, James is sent to a care home. After a series of misdemeanours, he is then drafted into CHERUB, part of The British Intelligence Service and it is there that his life really begins, with new friends and (joined in the second book) his sister Lauren.

James is transformed into a skilled CHERUB agent. He goes on to foil terrorists, uncover human trafficking, break kids out of jail, go undercover and become involved in other fantastic adventures. One of the reasons this series is so popular is that the characters are not from a James Bond high life. Rather the children are from under-privileged or troubled backgrounds and therefore easy for readers to relate to and sympathise with.

These books are a fantastic read. Buy 'The Recruit' first to do the scene setting and it won't be long before you are buying all of the books and impatiently awaiting the next volume. Recommended for older children/teenagers due to references to drugs and some swearing.
