

A NEW HOME FOR THE BELPER STEAM & VINTAGE EVENT

This year the Belper Steam & Vintage Event has moved to its new venue of Home Farm, at Street Lane Denby, by kind permission of Mr and Mrs Paul Sheward. The event will take place on Saturday 7th and Sunday the 8th of June. Throughout the weekend there will be displays of Steam



and Vintage Vehicles, including an Olde Thyme Fairground, tractors and stationary engines, models and miniatures. Other entertainment on and around the showground will be 'Cyril the Squirrel' Terrier Racing, the Hagley Falconry Display and performances from the Zallekah Egyptian Dancers and the Pauline Reader Can-Can Dancers. For the children there will be Giggles the Clown, Professor Gilbert Punch & Judy show and the Bourne Bloodhounds will be making an appearance.

Forget Crufts... Why not bring along your own dog and enter it into the 'Just For Dogs, dog show... you never know your dog might be the star of the show. There will be FREE entertainment in the beer tent on Friday and Saturday night. This will be provided by Six A Cross (Friday night) and The Remoulds (Saturday night) playing the sounds of the sixties. So why not come and enjoy the atmosphere.

The Belper Steam & Vintage Event was first established in 1989 as part of the Belper Festival fortnight. Since it's beginning, the event has grown and is now firmly established as one of the largest in the county. The event is held annually in June and has exhibits and attractions for the whole family. Whilst the enthusiasts will be engrossed in the vintage vehicles there will be plenty of charity, trade, craft and auto jumble stalls to keep spouses happy, not forgetting the Beer Tent along with the tasty food outlets. The Belper Steam and Vintage Event is a member of the National Traction Engine Trust and conforms to their standards and Code of Practice. The event is run by a small committee and any profits are donated to local charitable organisations.
